<b>1. Introduction :</b>	Professional ethics encompasses the personal and corporate standers of behavior expected of professionals.	2 hours
<b>2. Fundamental Concepts and Theoretical Foundation:</b>	Integrity, Accountability, Confidentiality, Respect, Honesty, Law, Loyalty, Objectivity, Responsibility, Trustworthiness, Compassion, Professional Behavior, Fairness, Sustainability, Punctuality etc are the fundamental concepts of Professional Ethics.	3 hours
<b>3. Ethics of Teaching Profession :</b>	Teachers should be motivated by a universal respect for human life and also be guided by principles of caring.	3 hours
<b>4. Legal Profession and Ethics :</b>	Professional ethics in law includes a moral code that governs how those working in the legal field and the practice of law should behave. The court and the administration of justice are the two entities to which every member of the legal profession owes a supreme responsibility.	4 hours
<b>5. Cyber Ethics :</b>	Cyber ethics is a branch of applied ethics that examines moral, legal and social issues at the intersections of computers/ information and communication technologies.	7 hours
<b>6. Media Ethics :</b>	Media Ethics is dealing with the specific ethical principles and standards of media, including broadcast media, film, theatre, the arts, print media and the internet. The field covers many varied and highly controversial topics.	6 hours
<b>7. Philosophical Counseling as Profession</b>	Philosophical Counseling was developing since the 1980s as a profession but since the 1950s as a practice. This counseling or consultation services to clients who look for a philosophical understanding of their lives, social problem or even mental problems. In the last case, philosophical counseling might in conjunction with psychotherapy.	5 hours
